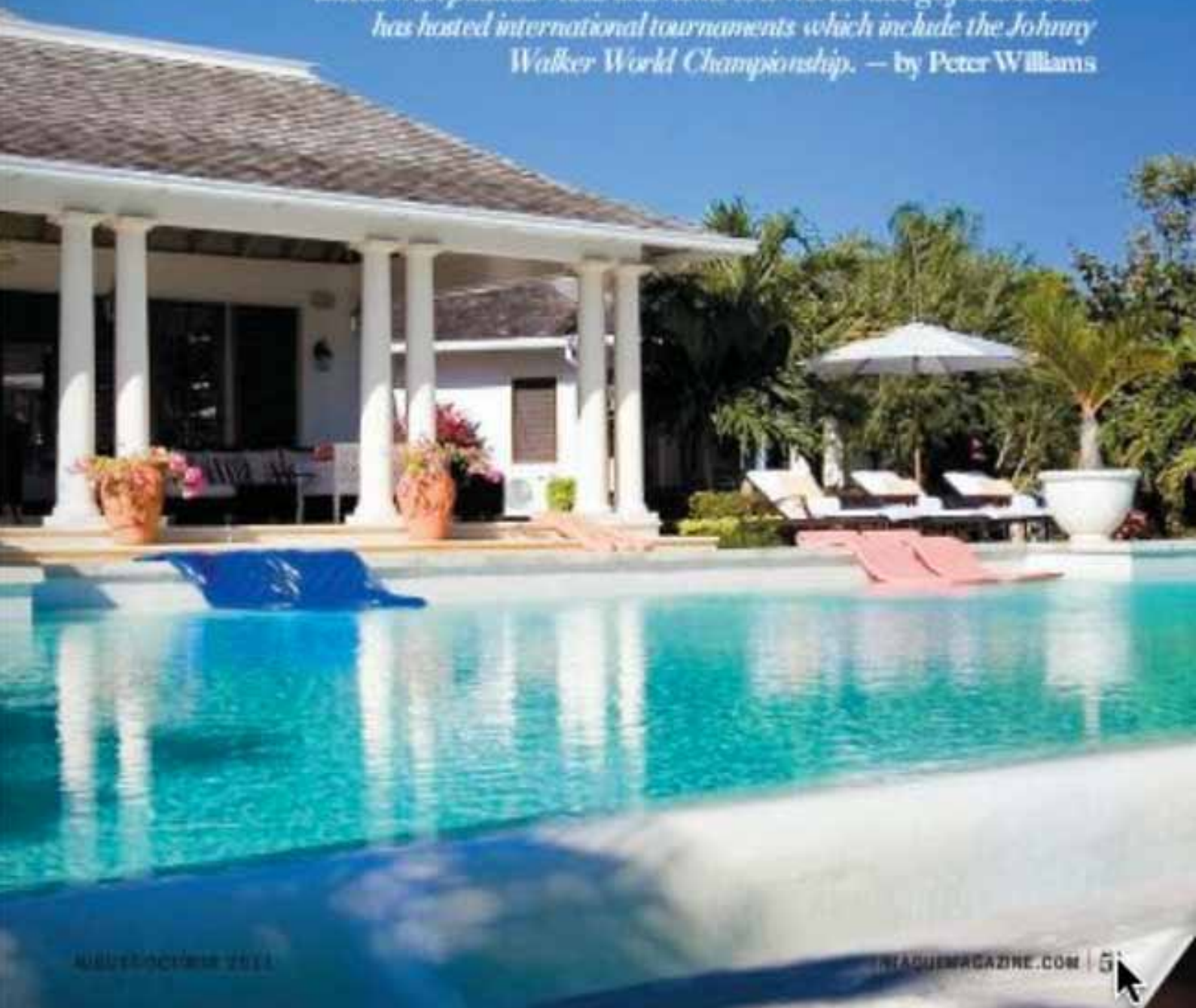




# A MATTER OF TASTE

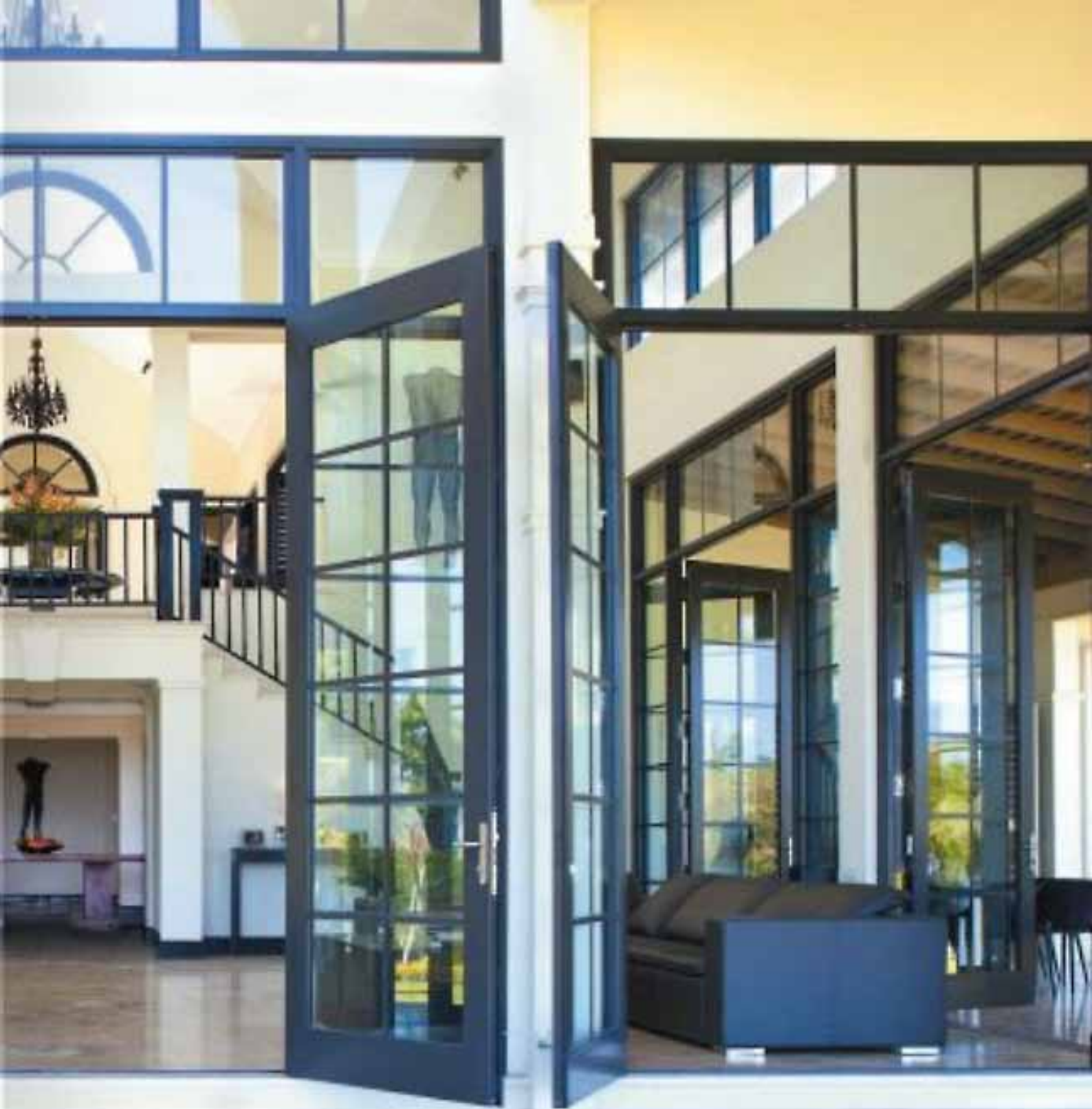

the hills, low hanging clouds caress the mountains, while hummingbirds - the signature icon of TRYALL CLUB, dart in between radiant blooms of fragrant tropical flowers.
